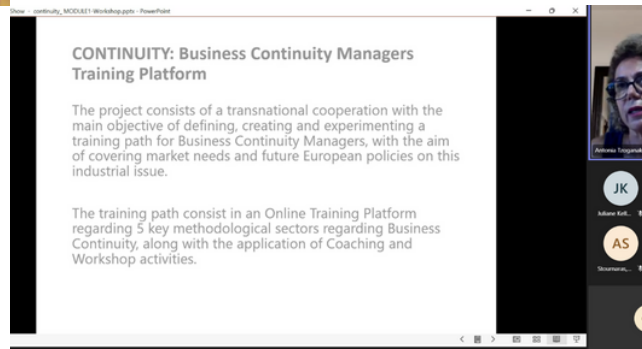
“The primary goal of these workshops was to fortify the resilience of organizations and professionals, enabling them to effectively confront and overcome disruptions in their operational landscapes.
